Unit 7

Unit 7 has been provided with a Dell laptop computer. This will automatically log in to the user *u3amember* on start-up. Two data projectors are provided: a high resolution short-throw Optoma model, suitable for displaying photographs and films and an Epson projector suitable for more general use (e.g. PowerPoint presentations). A fitted pull-down projection screen is installed on the wall furthest from the windows. There is also a folding projector/laptop stand stored next to the cupboard.

Two sets of blinds are fitted to the windows to provide appropriate levels of light in the room.

A Bluetooth speaker and a mains powered stereo speaker pair, a wireless presenter for remote slide changing and an extension cable reel are also provided.

This equipment is housed in a locked cupboard in the far left corner of the room as you come through the door. If you need a key for this cupboard contact me and I can either lend you one for one-off use or provide one for regular use. The cupboard contains instruction sheets for setting up the projectors and laptop but if you would like a run through, please let me know.

Unit 7 is fitted with a hearing induction loop system. You will find guidelines for its use displayed on the wall in the room.

Equipment for use outwith Unit 7

In addition to the equipment in Unit 7, the following items may be borrowed for use outwith Unit 7:

Dell laptop, Epson data projector and a small folding projection screen. I keep these at home. In the locked cupboard in Unit 7, but available to use outside Unit 7, are an older Epson data projector with VGA only input and a large folding projection screen in carry case
