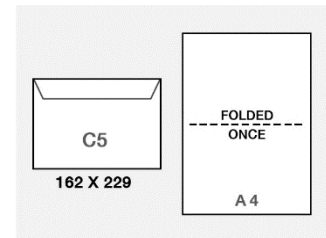
1. Go to <https://www.perth.u3asite.uk/welcome> and click on the [Join Us](#) link.
2. Follow the onscreen instructions. You need to key in details such as your name, email address, postal address, phone number(s). You can also give an emergency contact.
3. Perth u3a doesn't use membership photos, so please don't upload one.
4. Online payment of our membership fee (see below*.) This uses PayPal but you do **not** need a PayPal account – when you see this symbol, click to pay as a guest:



Join by Post

1. Complete the Membership Form.
2. Write a cheque (or a PO), payable to **Perth u3a** (see below*.) Remember to sign it.
3. Get a size C5 envelope, address it to yourself and attach a second class stamp.

A C5 envelope is 162mm x 229mm (6.4 inches x 9 inches) – designed to fit a sheet of A4 paper folded in half. We will use this envelope to send you our programme, it won't fit in a smaller envelope. If you only have an envelope larger than C5, fold it until it is C5 size otherwise you'll need a "Large Letter" 2nd class stamp.)



4. Use a second envelope to send the following items to me at this address:
Perth u3a Membership Secretary, 8 The Glebe, Dunning, PERTH, PH2 ORF
 - a. your completed form
 - b. your cheque (or PO) for the amount of your membership fee (see below *)
 - c. the stamped, self-addressed, size C5 envelope
5. We'll post your programme as soon as we can after we receive your form & payment.

* Membership Fees

£28 is the full annual individual membership fee for the Membership Year starting 1st August. If you join in April, May, or June, the *Summer Membership* fee is £10. Joining in July is again £28 and gives you membership for the following 13 months.

How we use your data

Please note that, to facilitate your membership, Perth u3a uses and shares your data as follows, under the lawful basis of *legitimate interest* defined in the UK GDPR and the Data Protection Act 2018:

- for administration, planning and management of Perth u3a
- to allow communication between group leaders and their group members
- to communicate information likely to be of interest to members of Perth u3a, for example:
 - news about Perth u3a
 - notices about meetings and events
 - information from the Third Age Trust and u3a Scotland.
- to share with the suppliers of our external membership management system and with the suppliers of services such as the printing of renewal invitations (if you do not have email).
- to send your name and address to the printers of *u3a matters* if you have opted to receive it.
- The minimum data required to enable your membership is your name, postal address and phone number. You can ask for your data to be corrected or ask not to receive *u3a matters* magazine by contacting a committee member (you can find contact details in our programme.)
