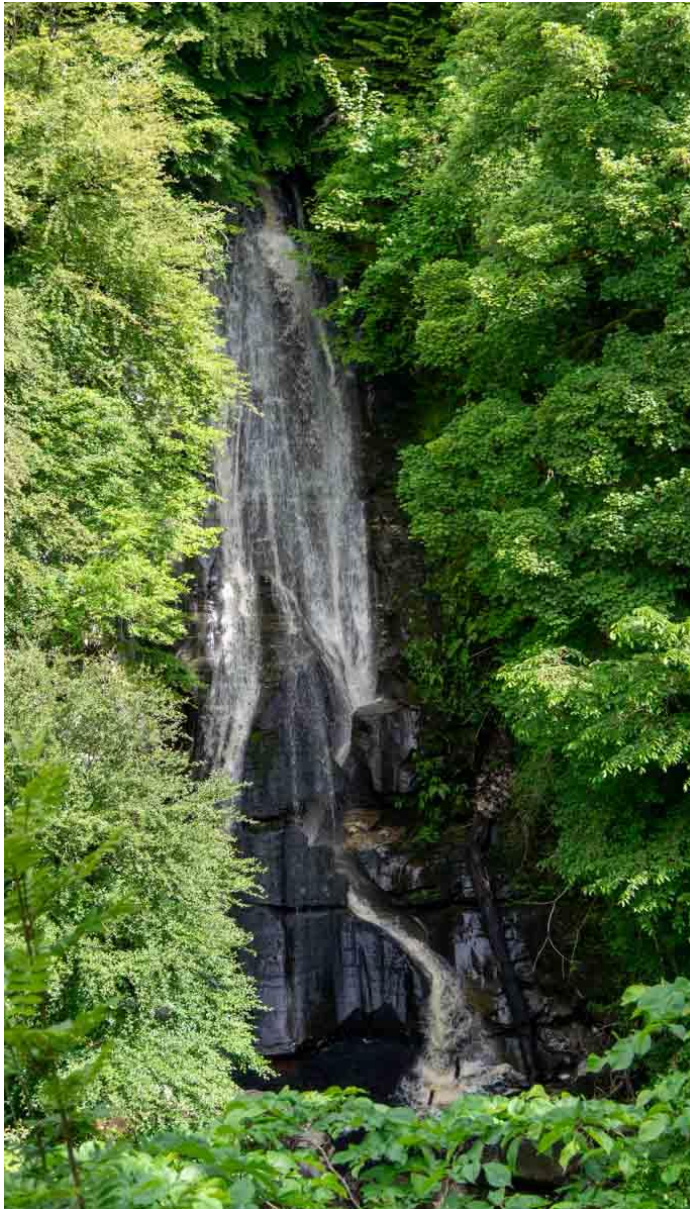


Upland Explorers 8/6/26 to Acharn.
